D.N.P.A.H.A. Bursary Application

The D.N.P.A.H.A. bursary program provides awards to students who are pursuing post-secondary studies in the fields of environmental, wildlife and natural resource sciences, conservation, aquaculture and natural resources law enforcement.

Candidates can come from the area surrounding Orangeville or be in the family of an Association Member. Candidates will be chosen from applications submitted to the Bursary Chairman, who will present them to the club Executives for selection and approval.

Eligibility

- Candidates must be enrolled/registered in a post-secondary program that supports wildlife and/or land and water research, enhancement, conservation, control or management.
- Must demonstrate how your education will help the environment
- Must demonstrate successful completion of a semester/year by providing the D.N.P.A.H.A. with updates as to your progress (i.e. an academic transcript)
- Be willing to speak with the D.N.P.A.H.A. (by letter/in person) about what you have learned from your studies and how it will help the environment

Value

- Bursaries of \$1200.00 a year available to 3 eligible recipients
- Each Bursary is awarded for a duration of two years
- Bursaries are awarded based on the academic calendar of the school being attended
 - Full year – Half of the Bursary (\$600.00) will be awarded upon enrollment and half (\$600.00) will be awarded upon successful completion of the academic year.
 - Semestered (based on two semesters) – \$300.00 upon proof of enrollment in semester one, \$300.00 upon successful completion of semester one, \$300.00 upon proof of enrollment in semester two, \$300.00 upon successful completion of semester two.
